

Breaking news...thiopurine induced pancreatitis (TIP) REOPENED.

We have some exciting genetic results in this arm of the study. We have submitted a manuscript for review and hope to hear soon. We will keep you updated with this. In light of these promising data we have decided to **REOPEN TIP.** We have ethics approval to extend all the side arms so no further actions needs to be taken in terms of ethics/R&D approval. Therefore all 6 of the studies in PRED4 are open until at least the end of 2014.

Reminder of the inclusion criteria for the 2 new arms: Sulfasalazine Induced Neutropaenia (SAN)

- History of inflammatory bowel disease or Rheumatoid Arthritis
- History of Sulfasalazine exposure in the previous 30 days
- Normal total white cell count and neutrophil count at baseline
- Fall in neutrophil count to ≤0.5 x10⁹/L
- Medical opinion implicating Sulfasalazine leads to dose reduction or drug withdrawal (even if temporary)

Thiopurine Induced Liver Injury (TIH)

- History of inflammatory bowel disease
- Normal ALT and bilirubin at baseline
- No pre-existing liver disease
- Elevation of ALT and/or bilirubin to ≥ 5 times upper limit of normal (guidance >175 for female and >200 for males.)
- History of thiopurine exposure in the previous 30 days prior to this abnormal blood test
- Medical opinion implicating thiopurine in development of hepatotoxicity
